- CH1 See Roll of Honour
- CH2 (Wooden plaque behind the organ) To the loving memory of HARRIET BELCHER 1878 - 1953. This plaque is placed here by her family and friends.
- CH2A (Brass plaque on wooden panelling to bell tower) This screen has been dedicated to the memory of CHARLIE AND KATH GRAINGE. Lifelong worshippers in this Church.
- CH3 Wall painting (Cleaned, documented & stabilised by Ann Ballantine in 1995)
- CH4 (Stained glass window) To the memory of FREDERICK ANTHONY DENNY born 1860 died 1941 and his only son JOHN ANTHONY DENNY born 1889 died 1942 of Horwood House in this parish.
- CH5 This memorial is placed by MAUD DENNY in loving memory of her husband and son Easter 1946.
- CH6 Sacred to the memory of the Rev. STEPHEN LANGSTON. For 26 years Vicar of this parish during which period he laboured among the people of his charge to lead them to the knowledge of the truth as it is in Jesus. He died 13, March 1816 in his 51st yr. This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptation that Christ Jesus came into the World to save sinners of whom I am the chief. 1st Timothy 1st Chapter 15th Verse.
Also of HENRY WILLIAM LANGSTON his seventh child who died 19, Aug. 1817 in his 21st year.
- CH7 This chancel was restored in 1889 to the glory of God and in loving memory PHILIP DAUNCEY lay rector, by his widow.
- CH8 To the glory of God and in grateful memory of AMOS HALL 2nd Batt. Yorkshire L.I. died of wounds 22, Oct. 1915 and of AMOS SHILLINGFORD 4th Batt. Ox & Bucks L.I. killed 15, June 1918.
"They gave their lives for King and Country in the Great War 1914 - 1918."
- CH9 In affectionate memory of EMMA ELIZABETH DAUNCEY widow of PHILIP DAUNCEY of Horwood House. Born Aug. 6, 1832. Died June 6, 1909. "Peace Perfect Peace" This tablet was erected by her sister-in-law.
- CH10 Sacred to the memory of SIR STEPHEN LANGSTON Knt. Alderman of the City of London and Patron of this Church: who twice served the Office of High Sheriff, first for this County in the critical years 1788 & 1789 afterwards for the City of London & County of Middlesex in the no less arduous periods of 1796 & 1797. "Active and enterprising in his disposition he dedicated his labours to the Glory of God and the Public Good, and while honouring the Lord with his substance the Divine Blessing richly descended on him.
Also of Dame REBECCA LANGSTON whose eminence in every social and domestic virtue, proved her a wife worthy of such an husband. Partaking of his pious spirit and co-operating in his benevolent designs during their union of nearly 33 years: After they had together trained up 3 sons and 7 daughters, June 5th 1797 in her 58th year. She was called away only a few months before him: for Nov 5th following at the age of 55 he quitted this vain & transitory scene and hastened to join her in those triumphant songs of which Jesus is the immortal theme. "The shrouded dead a solemn charge shall give to teach thee and survivors how to live. Catching the bright example left behind their faith we follow and their rest we find"
- CH11 Sacred to the memory of Mrs. REBECCA LANGSTON Relict of the Revd. STEPHEN LANGSTON who died Feb. 20th 1825 aged 52 years. "Thanks be to God which giveth us the victory, through our Lord Jesus Christ"
Also of REBECCA HURT LANGSTON, eldest daughter of the above. Died Feb. 8th 1835 aged 44.
"Blessed are the dead that die in the Lord"
- CH12 (Brass plaque) In proud and loving memory of CHRISTOPHER EDGAR RICCARD R.A. and MARK PRICE VICCARS, Suffolk Regiment who gave their lives in the war 1939 - 1945.

- CH14 (Stained glass window, East) In memory of MICHAEL BRUCE URQUHART DEWAR. Born 5th Aug. 1886. Died 21st Dec. 1950. Some time High Sheriff of Hertfordshire. Chief of British Tank Mission to U.S.A. 1940 - 43, which produced the Sherman tanks for the Battle of El Alamein.
- CH15 (Wooden plaque by the pulpit) Remembered with love and gratitude NEVILLE WALLACE 1936 - 1990. Reader for 25 years.
- CH16 Brass plaque with the first line of each of the ten commandments and underneath this inscription "Both old and young these laws have befit, Which God himself in Sinai writ" dated 1641.
- CH17 (Brass plaque in vestry) This vestry was erected & dedicated in Oct 1926. Rev. J.C. Duncan M.A. Vicar. W.A. Davies & M. Illing, Churchwardens.
- CH18 Bell tower; This church was new pewed and repaired in the year 1830 by which means 71 additional sittings were obtained, and in consequence of a grant from the Incorporated Society for promoting the enlargement, building and repairing of Churches and Chapels, 58 of that number are hereby declared to be free and unappropriated for ever: in addition to 138 sittings formerly provided 50 of which was free. The Rev. J.W. Harding Minister. John Curtis & John Leeson, Churchwardens.
